Read Matthew 9:35-38

5. How does someone grow in compassion? Why is compassion difficult (or easy) for you?
6. What does it mean to be harassed and helpless? Who are some people you know that feel that way? How does the Gospel of Jesus Christ help? How can you demonstrate or proclaim that to them?
