



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

PART 1

LUKE 5:1-11

One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding round him and listening to the word of God. He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from the shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.

1. Submitting your current role, to the Lordship of Christ

1.1 I know what I'm doing, but you know what, because You say so, I'm going to trust you.

1.2 This is one of the hardest, when we think we know better than Jesus — the willingness to say, because you say so.

1.3 Now this is important, because in the roles that we have — mother, father, sister, brother, daughter, employee, student, friend, significant other — those roles, which define us — and all the pressures that come with it. The unsaid expectations... we need to be willing to submit that role to Jesus.

1.4 What does that mean? Submit your role to Jesus?


1.1.4.1 Many of our roles involve listening and engaging with someone else. Our boss, Our manager, our spouse? And it's in that can often bring tension. We should do it differently. We could do it better.

1.1.4.2 And it's important — Peter was a good fisherman. This was his living. Maybe he was a great fisherman. We don't know. But at this moment he's willing to say, okay Jesus, because you say so.

1.5 Jesus knows how you can be a better father, a mother, a sister, a brother, a daughter, a son, a husband, a wife, a single person, an employee — and it's that first step,

okay Jesus, what do you say? What should I do?

I want to be a better so and so... if that's the case, then submit to Christ.



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2 points of obedience.

3. Two Points of Obedience

* 3.1 Let out into deeper water (not specific. peter is still playing a role here as a fisherman. Does he just go generally into the deeper water? Sometimes we wait for specifics from God when really he just wants us to obey. There may not be a specific action in place, aside from set out to deeper water. Things will unfold as they go.)


* 3.2 Let down your nets (see it through. Again this isn't an act of faith on Peters part. It's an act of obedience. He doesn't believe he's going to catch fish. He just says, okay Jesus, because you say so I will do it. The amazing thing is, Peter does this before even realising Jesus is God. If you and I know who Jesus is, shouldn't we be more deliberate about obeying him?)

* 3.3 Step forward. Move into action.

* 3.4 If the first step is a willingness to obey, the second step is to actually do it.

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
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

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
up until now Peter is obeying Jesus because he's a great teacher — not because he's the son of God, not even because he necessarily believes. And this is even after all the teaching. And being in the boat with him.

But after this.. .after this miracle .. .it's this response that we need to get to the point. Not just obedience...


When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, 'Go away from me, Lord; I am a **sinful man!**' For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners.

When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, 'Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!' For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners.



But after this, he falls before Jesus, and says, Go away from me because I am sinful. The response to the glory and realisation of God's infinite power and might is one of humble repentance. And he's saying it maybe because of his lack of faith, maybe because he knows he is a sinful man, but at the very least, he knows he has no right to be in the presence of Jesus.

If our first step is saying obeying Him, and saying He knows better, the second step, which is even more difficult is acknowledging who He really is, and who we really are. We are sinful people, who's hearts and intentions second guess God, full of pride, insecurity, jealousy, rage, - and that realisation should drive us to Jesus, and His goodness ...



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Then Jesus said to Simon,
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But even as Peter is saying, go away from me, he's really pleading, don't leave me. And Jesus says, I will make you fishers of men.

Jesus make me. Obedience to God is the beginning step of letting God make you. Humility is the realisation that you need to be made by God. And the encouragement here is that Jesus is not rejecting you, but rather welcoming you into being made into His mission.



Respond : If you are currently in a stage where you are struggling in your role in life : feeling confusion, or doubt, or discouragement, or negative thoughts about your ability, or about the people around you - I invite you to pray this prayer with me today.

God, you know me. You know my situation. You know my weaknesses, my struggles, my hearts condition. But I hear your voice today, and I obey you. I submit my identity to you. Because you say it, I will follow. Holy Spirit, speak the Words of Christ to me now.

If you know your life is out of sync with God, I invite you as we worship, to come before Him. Recognise that You are in the same boat as him, and come and repent, humble and awestruck, desperately yearning for God.
